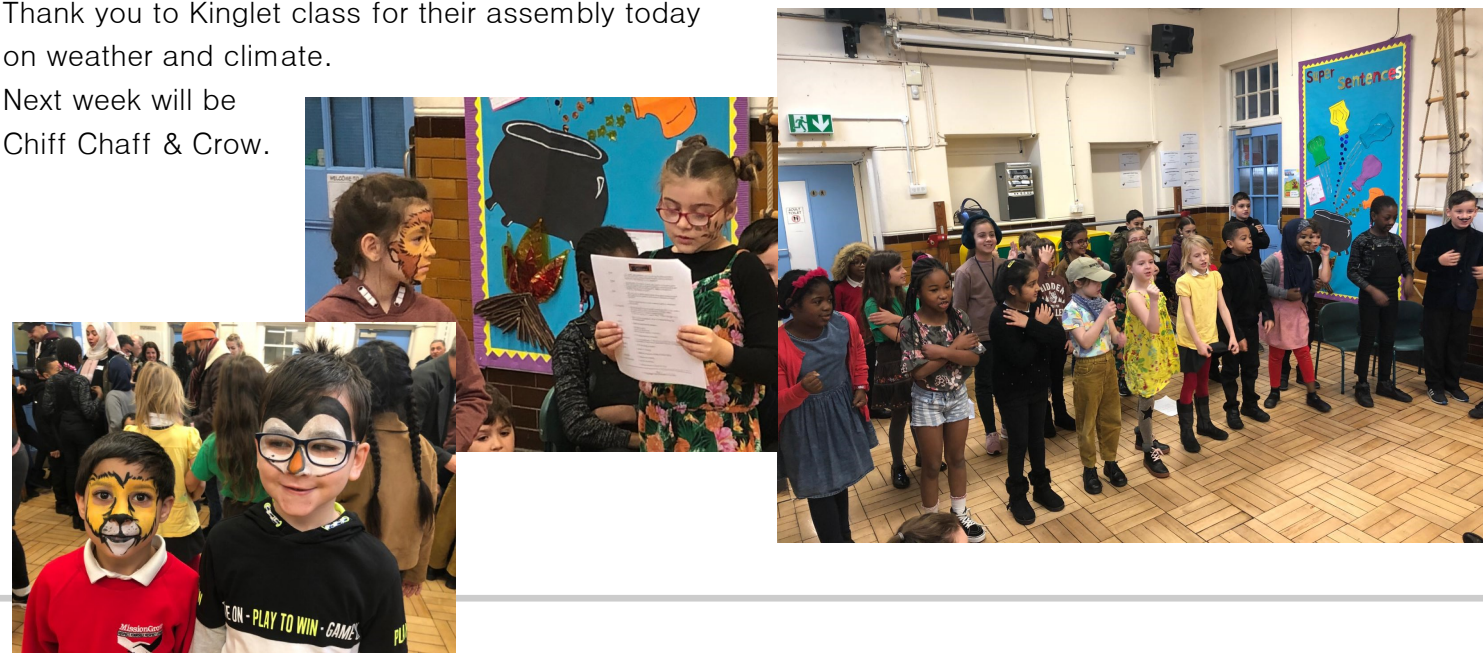
On line games advice
